

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (NSS) :

The National Service Scheme (NSS), Government J.Thankima College Unit has been introduced in the year 1994 consisting of Two Units. Within a short period of time, the college has active NSS Units with Four Programme Officers to give the students leadership and guidance in social works. The Programme Officers are appointed by the Principal for a period of two years. Those selected Programme Officers supervised the working of the student volunteers under the various programmes being chalked out in line with the instructions particularly under the Regular and Special Camp Activities. At present, the NSS Units was guided by four Programme Officers, namely:-

1. Mr Zoramthanga (Department of Political Science)
2. Ms Sangrozami (Department of Mizo)
3. Mr B.Lalzarzova (Department of Mizo)
4. Mrs Janet Sangkungi Pachuau (Department of History)

Since its inception in the college, the regular activities and the special camping activities are regularly and actively take part for augmenting the students' capabilities in terms of better quality of work ethics.

Almost all the students enrolled as NSS Volunteers take part in NSS activities like Tree plantation, Health & Family Welfare Programmes, Creation of community assets, organized voluntary Blood Donation Camp in the college campus at least one in every year, participation in the National Integration Camps in the National Level and other social services of the community which help them to develop their personality. The NSS Units has done a remarkable service both in the State and National Levels.

The important activities of Govt.J.Thankima College, NSS Units during 2008-2012 are:

A – REGULAR ACTIVITIES:

Afforestation & Plantation: Under Regular Activities, two plantations – Sihmui Plantation and Durtlang Plantation were visited at least twice in every year cleaning, weeding, fencing and planting new samplings as required. Many of the student volunteers and Programme Officers are participated.

Blood Donation Camp: Voluntary Blood Donation Camp was organised yearly and sometimes in collaboration with Red Ribbon Club at the hospitals or if possible at the college campus. In these occasions, resource person are invited from outside to deliver a speech. Students Volunteers and teachers donating blood for people in need of blood.

Creation of Community Assets: Under Regular Activities, Public Urinals and Toilets were constructed at Lungdai Village, College Veng and some parts in Aizawl locality. Student Rest shed was constructed at college campus, renovated public urinal at Sihphir Village and public bathroom at Nisapui Village.

Cleanliness Drive: Cleanliness drive and campaign was organised a number of times at the college campus and different adopted villages every year. Many NSS volunteers and teachers are participated in these programmes.

Observation of Important Days: Some important days are observed and activities are carried out in every year. Since its inception, we observed and celebrated some of the important days having function and participate student volunteers and teachers at different levels.

Participation: Programme Officers and the selected volunteers participate and attend the important programmes, meetings, seminar and consultation in different places at different levels every year like Orientation Training, Trainer's Training on Life Skills, Inter State Youth Exchange & Home Stay Programme. From these, the student volunteers and the Programme Officers had gained a lot of knowledge.

B – SPECIAL CAMPING ACTIVITIES:

November 2008: Special Camping was organised at Thingsai Village. The following activities were taken up:

1. Constructed Public Water Tank and two Public Urinal at different area.
2. Visited Mizo Historical Places.
3. Cleanliness work.
4. Environment Management Campaign.

March 2009: Special Camping was organised at our adopted village Bawngkawn. The following activities were taken up:

1. Construction of Public Urinal.
2. Cleanliness Campaign and work.

June 2010: Under the Special Camping Programme, Special Camp were organised in Bukpui Village and Durtlang Village. Two Public Urinals, Public Toilet and Public Water Tank were constructed in these special camps. Many student volunteers, Programme Officers and local volunteers participated in the construction works.

December 2011: During 6-11 December, 22 volunteers along with four Programme Officers attended Special Camping at Sentlang Village and Lungdai Village. In this Special Camping, one waiting shed at Sentlang Village and two Public Urinals at Lungdai Village are constructed.

Special Camping was organised at Neihbawih Village during 11-17 May'2011. With the support of Young Mizo Association (YMA), it was constructed waiting shed. During this period, the Programme Officers conducted discussion programme in the Community Hall on the theme of "Health, Public Sanitation and Personal Hygiene." Moreover, the Programme Officers and some volunteers had an opportunity to conduct interview with the prominent citizens like Village Council President, School Teachers etc. and expressed their views, opinion and the steps they have taken so far.
