The Students' Evangelical Union of Government J Thankima College was established on the 29th September, 2009. It is registered under 'The Mizoram Students' Evangelical Union' Headquarters, Aizawl.

Aims and objectives of the Union:

Sources of income :

The Students' Evangelical Union elects the office bearers and forms a Committee annually which decides and initiate various activities undertaken by the Union.

Regular activity of the Union :

Members attended Mizoram Students' Evangelical Union Orientation Programme or Convention which is conducted by the Headquarter.

A fellowship programme is organised once in a week within the College.

Activities of the Students' Evangelical Union :

2009-2010:

During the first year of its inception there were six (6) office bearers and ten (10) committee members from the students selected by Students' Union leaders of the College.

2009 - 2010:

1. Organised an Advance Christmas celebration in the College.
2. Visited a charity institution Thutak Nunpui Tu (TNT) Camp at Zuangtui, Aizawl and handed Rs. 1500/- only as charity donation. Inmates of this camp comprises orphans, drug addicts and mentally ill and the like.
3. The Union purchased a new guitar.

2010-2011

1. Conducted a One Day Retreat for the students, at a Prayer Mountain in Aizawl.
2. The Union formed the SEU Choir of Government J. Thankima College which is comprised of 50 members and hed performed on many occasions within and outside the College. The Choir recorded a 30 minutes of 'Youth Programme', at Doordhashan Kendra, Aizawl.
3. A steel almirah was purchased.
4. An Advance Christmas celebration was organised in the College.

2011-2012

1. Three (3) of the office bearers attended Orientation Programme organised by Mizoram Students' Evangelical Union on 24th-27th August, 2011 at Synod Conference Hall,
2. In collaboration with the College Students' Union, the Evangelical Students' Union organised a One Day Crusade on 9th September, 2011 at the College campus, and another One Day Retreat was organised on 28th September, 2011 at Tourist Resort Centre, Beraw, Aizawl.
3. Membera attended the '4th Mizoram Students' Evangelical Union's Spiritual Convention' at Hrangbana College, Chanmari on 11th November, 2011
4. Charity to a poor widow at Zemabawk, Aizawl and patients in the Aizawl Civil Hospital were given during the month of December, 2011.

2012-2013

1. Fund raising: During the Annual College Week, tea stalls were set up for selling tea and snacks. Menial works for fund raising were organised as and when there is opportunity.

2. EU Choir: There had been standing choir consisting 50 members throughout the year. Choir practices were held during class recesses.
